

From the opening scenes, this book is one erotic encounter after another and each one gets hotter! Bianca is adventurous, open and ready to take on challenges, something she will find plenty of at The Academy. After her incredible interview, Bianca meets the bosses then proceeds to enlighten herself, and us, in all ways a Sex Therapist can work. Erotic, titillating and almost too hot to touch, this book is arousal on Kindle form and it's good, VERY good. There is no flow to this book and the characters are constantly waffling between who they like and don't like. The POV was hard to follow. One of my biggest problems was that I couldn't seem to get a handle on exactly what this academy was all about. Somehow, for the main character, it's a job, a training facility, and a weird "therapeutic" setting all at once. You're supposed to believe that it's commonplace for people to be committed, against their wills, to a facility that forces uncomfortable (and downright painful) sexual situations.

The only thing this book has going for it is lots of kinky sex. The story did not hold my attention and with an overwhelming amount of cruelty for no apparent reason, I lost interest. I did not care about any of the characters and connected with no one.

The title really caught my attention, but I was really disappointed. Sorry, but I DNF. The dialog jumped so much, I was getting confused as to who was supposed to be talking. And some of it was just gross, especially the dirty old man & the things the woman had to do. It was kind of ridiculous. Not sexy at all.

This book has very little plot or flow and to call it BDSM is just a crime. BDSM should be safe, sane and consensual! None of the above happens in this book. Don't get me wrong it has hot kinky sex but even that is sick and twisted. It's like watching 80's porn.

Reviews were bad, it was free, so I thought why not? Well, it really is bad. I only got 20% in before ending the torture. Bad writing can't save this interesting premise. No sexual therapy going on, just humiliation and games. Don't bother.

BDSM Academy by Lexis Alexander is the worst piece of trash I have ever read. Don't get me wrong, I have read some fine BDSM novels with great stories that were well written with really interesting characters. This questionable work does not fall into that category. The characters in this book were the most unlikable and perverse group of misfits ever created for the printed page. Instead of a story this book read more like a horrifying nightmare. I actually enjoyed deleting this one from my Kindle.

The blurb made this sound interesting, but it didn't quite deliver all that it could. The author shows promise but the actual plot wasn't developed enough. This book has a ton of sex scenes that are thinly linked by some plot threads. The vacillating POVs make it incredibly hard to follow. All the characters are fickle in their opinions and the book needs serious editing help. If this author could find an editor to work with her work could be amazing.
