

Finding Adam was such a sweet story of two young men who find one another when they least

Jase had his own reasons for agreeing but he hated doing it, especially once he met Adam, his new roommate. As they got to know one another, Jase was unable to continue with the plan, and things changed considerably for them both once Jase admitted what he was told to do and once Adam was aware of his father's attempted manipulation. This is my first Dillon Hunter story and I really enjoyed it! It had everything I look for in a MM romance!
