

Most of the resources provided in this book are shown in Ricci's first book, albeit in smaller format. The information and handouts in this book are certainly helpful and I will use them, but I wouldn't recommend buying both books--just buy this one and you'll be ready to teach colleagues, parents, and students about the growth mindset.
